

Do you know what you have? Types of health insurance

Documents you should have:

- Summary of Benefits and Coverage
- Evidence of Coverage <u>sample</u>

Do you need a Referral? a Prior Authorization?

- Take a Screenshot!

Avoiding Debt Don't Have Insurance?



See if you qualify for health coverage:

- Medicaid
- Connect for Health Colorado open enrollment is from Nov 1 to Jan 15 OR a Qualifying Life Event

You can shop around for care

Make sure you received a "Good Faith Estimate"

Apply for Hospital Discounted Care/Hospital Financial Assistance

- You can qualify for HDC if you have insurance BUT YOU
- MUST ASK!

Avoiding Debt Know what you'll pay



Shop around - Hospital Price Transparency -

Hospitals must post standard charges for at least 300 shoppable services that can be planned in advance, along with a description and any other services the hospital customarily provides with it. x-rays, outpatient visits, imaging and laboratory tests or bundled services such as a colonoscopy.

Avoiding Debt Know what you'll pay



Get a written estimate AND make sure you know what it includes

- Is there a <u>Facility Fee</u>?
- Estimates ARE estimates!

Unless they're **Good Faith Estimates**

- uninsured or choose to not use insurance

After you get a bill for the items or services, if the billed amount is \$400 or more above the good faith estimate, you can dispute the bill.

Balance Billing Protections

Emergency care

-you can't be charged more than in-network cost sharing

Planned, non-emergency

- -you can't be charged more than in-network cost sharing if you are at an in-network facility and seen by an out-of-network provider
 - applies to hospital, hospital outpatient department, ambulatory surgical center)
- Labs can be tricky....and so can ambulances....





You can't be asked to sign away your rights re balance billing- Notice and consent form

Your provider of facility may ask you to sign a notice and consent form if you are scheduled to get:

- Some types of care from an out-of-network provider at an innetwork facility
- Post-stabilization services from an out-of-network provider or facility

You shouldn't get a notice and consent form in the emergency room, from Assistant surgeons, Hospitalists, Intensivists



Don't pay upfront

wait until insurance has processed the claim and you receive an **EOB**

Compare the bill to the EOB

If something doesn't seem right, ask!

- Call your provider
- Call insurance

You have the right to appeal! You have the right to complain!

Network Adequacy

Hospital Discounted Care

When you can't afford the bill

- -Anyone can qualify as long as income is up to 250% FPL
- -Establishes a monthly payment plan based on your monthly income
- -Limits the actions hospitals/collections agencies can take against you
- -Requires all communication (written/verbal) in your preferred language
- -You don't have to be a U.S. citizen or have a certain immigration status
